NSW Plant Pathology & Mycology Herbarium Virtual Tour

The NSW Plant Pathology and Mycology Herbarium was founded in 1890, with the start of the department of Agricultural in New South Wales, Australia. Diagnosticians and researchers have been accessioning material into the collection for over 130 years and the collection has grown to contain over 100,000 dried specimens and some 7,000 living cultures. These specimens form the official disease records for the state and enables trade and market access for our growers by showing area of freedom for plant diseases. These extensive collections also demonstrate host range, distribution, adaptations to climate, and are a valuable source of genetic information for diagnostic development and research. Join Dr Jordan Bailey as she introduces you to world of plant pathogen and fungal preservation and the history and importance of the collection.
